13. The manner of Execution of Subsidy Schemes.

1.1. Please provide the information as per the following formats.

1- Name of Programme/Scheme.

(i) 102- Soil Conservation Scheme (06/Afforestation 31-Grant-in-Aid/Contribution subsidies.

(ii) 102-Soil Conservation Scheme (09) Cash/Horticultural Crop Development Works.

(iii) 800-Other Expenditures (04) Watershed Management Scheme (08) Afforestation 31-/(09) Cash/Horticultural Crops Development work Grant-in-aid/Contribution subsidies.

2- Duration of the Programme.

3 to 5 years.

- Objective of the scheme/programme

(i) Afforestation:

- To provide vegetative cover to barren and denuded hill slopes.
- To protect the land from further erosion.
- To maintain a favourable effect of soil cover.
- To meet the fuel-wood, timber requirements and other indirect benefits to be accrued from the system, on a sustainable-mode under proper management systems.

(ii) Cash/Horticulture Crops Development Work:

- To combat the prevalent un-sustainable agricultural practices namely, jhum/Bun Cultivation.
- To dissipate surface-runoff and further soil loss.
- To provide better prospects for assured remunerative income from their holdings.
- To create a conducive, eco-friendly and people's friendly environment for weaning the Jhum/Bun Cultivators.

4- Eligibility of Beneficiary :

- Recognized individuals/Group/Community, Cooperation farming Society, registered under the Meghalaya Cooperative Societies Act (Assam Act 1 of 1948 as adapted by Meghalaya), with proof, that they are the genuine farmers/farming community from the local institutions/bodies.
- Subject to field verification and inquiry to be conducted by the Divisional Soil & Water Conservation Office, Territorial Division, in case of Afforestation and Cash Crops Division for the Cash/Horticultural Crops Development works respectively.

5- Procedure to avail the benefits of the programme/scheme.

By putting in an application in a plain paper.

6- Criteria for deciding eligibility.

- ❖ Production of land ownership documents issued by a competent authority.
- ❖ Recommendation from the Traditional & Local Institutions/ Bodies in case of the applicants who are cultivating in the community land(s).
- ❖ Choice of coops shall be done in accordance with the compatibility and suitability of the area/region (Agro-eco-climatic parameters).
- ❖ Signing the 'Deed of Agreement' before awarding the scheme.
