

***Section 4(1) (b)(i) of Right To Information Act,2005***  
***The Particulars of its organizations, functions and duties***

The State Transport Authority is set up by a Government notification under Section 68 of the Central Motor Vehicles Act,1988. The powers and functions of the State Transport Authority is enumerated under sub-section (3) of Section 68 of the Central Motor Vehicles Act,1988. The jurisdiction of the State Transport Authority covers the entire State of Meghalaya.

The State Transport Authority comprises of three Official members, i.e. the Commissioner & Secretary, Govt. of Meghalaya, Transport Department who function as the Chairman of the Authority, the Commissioner of Transport as Member and the Deputy Commissioner of Transport as the Member - Secretary. Besides the official members there are also two Non-official members nominated by the Government.

The functions of the State Transport Authority is to receive applications and issue Inter-State permit and also Inter-District permit to Buses, Trucks and Light commercial vehicles.
