The Particulars of its organizations, functions and duties

The Regional Transport Authority is set up by a Government notification under Section 68 of the Central Motor Vehicles Act,1988. The powers and functions of the Regional Transport Authority is enumerated under sub-section (3) of Section 68 of the Central Motor Vehicles Act,1988. The jurisdiction of the Regional Transport Authority comprises of areas within the respective Districts, also known as Regions.

The Regional Transport Authority comprises of two Official members, i.e. the Deputy Commissioner and the District Transport Officer and one non-official member who is nominated by Government.

The functions of the Regional Transport Authority is to receive applications and issue permits for different categories of vehicles of the concerned District or Region.
