

CHAPTER – 5
Norms set by the Board for the discharge of its functions
[Section 4 (1) (b) (iv)]

1. The Meghalaya Transport Corporation is a statutory body established under a special statute, namely, the Road Transport Corporations Act, 1950. The Corporation therefore performs and discharges its functions, duties and responsibility in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and the Meghalaya Transport Corporation Rules, 1976 (which was framed under the said Act).
2. In running its offices, the Corporation follows, as far as practicable, all the existing Rules, Regulations, Circulars and Instructions issued by the Government, such as the FRs & SRs, T.A. Rules, Conduct Rules, Discipline and Appeal Rules, the Secretariat Manual of Office Procedure and the Handbook of General Circulars, etc.
3. As regards operation of bus services, the Corporation is following the standard procedure for running of bus services.
